TEAM CAPTAINS -IMPORTANT- you must complete the entry form before mailing

1. This USBC sanctioned tournament is open to all members of the OAHU USBC Bowling Association.

ALL BOWLERS MUST SHOW THEIR 2017-18 USBC BA CARD OR PAYMENT RECEIPT AT CHECK-IN.

Eligible non-members living within OAHU USBC Bowling Association's jurisdiction may enter by paying \$25.00 for an associate membership card or \$12 local association (includes outer Island member) fee if you have another association's current card.

2. ENTRY FEE:

HANDICAP EVENTS

TEAM \$25 / DOUBLES \$25 / SINGLES \$25 \$75
ALL EVENTS (optional) \$5 (\$80)

(OPTIONAL) SCRATCH EVENTS

TEAM \$12 / DOUBLES \$12 / SINGLES \$12 \$36
ALL EVENTS \$5 (\$41)

Participants who have entered and paid the fees for the regular handicap tournament may enter any or all of the optional scratch events (Team, Doubles, Singles & 9 game All Events) by paying the optional fee(s). To be eligible for team scratch (all) team members must enter. For doubles scratch both partners must enter.

3. ALL ENTRIES CLOSE ON JANUARY 27, 2018

(must be postmarked Midnight January 27, 2018)

--Entry Forms must be filled out in detail.

--List team and doubles line up in the order of bowling. -

-If a substitute is needed, he/she will bowl in the original entrant's position.

--Once the schedule is finalized, no switching of the line ups or partners will be allowed.

--Please submit all entries early to enable officials to get the schedule out promptly.

4. FULL ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM.

All entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Telephone reservations will not be accepted. OAHU USBC BA will date stamp and assign the entry number when received if full payment is with entry form. Partial entry fee will delay the entry number assignment. Entry forms will only be accepted at the OBA office in person or mailed in. Entries may not be given to any official to turn in. Cash, checks or money orders are accepted forms of

payment. However, any checks returned or not honored by the bank will be assessed a \$30.00 fee and full payment including assessed fee must be made (cash or money order) within 10 days of notification

NO REFUNDS OF ENTRY FEES WILL BE AVAILABLE AFTER THE SCHEDULE IS FINALIZED USBC RULE 314.

5. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION is permitted in TEAM EVENT ONLY.

The teams MUST consist of two (2) different members to be eligible to cash more than once.

The first score bowled in any event will be used for an individual's all events total.

6. FORMAT: The tournament will consist of a four-person team event, doubles, singles and all events. Three games will be bowled in each event. DOUBLES will be bowled first followed with Singles. Doubles cannot be bowled without singles and vice versa.

7. AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS FOR 2018 OAHU USBC BA CITY CHAMPIONSHIPS verified from BOWL.COM

A. SPORT, CHALLENGE or STANDARD AVERAGES

- 1) If you have SPORT, CHALLENGE & STANDARD averages, your highest standard average shall be used.
- 2) If you have only a SPORT OR CHALLENGE AVERAGE, THE USBC ADJUSTMENT SCALE WILL BE USED.
- 3) The adjustment scale is not considered a "re-rate". Its purpose is to allow for a fair adjustment to what would be expected of the bowler on a standard condition. The adjustment scale does not supersede the tournament manager's ability to further adjust upward any bowler's tournament entering average per Rule 319C."

B. Highest USBC certified league average to include composite, based on 21 games or more from:

- 1) 2016-17 season or
- 2) 2015-16 season or
- 3) 2014-15 season

C. Bowlers who do not meet the average requirements stated in Item A or Item B will enter with the highest of the following:
