RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This USBC-sanctioned tournament is open to all members of the Oahu USBC Bowling Association. **ALL BOWLERS MUST SHOW THEIR 2016-17 USBC-BA CARD OR PAYMENT RECEIPT AT CHECK-IN.** Eligible non-members living within Oahu USBC Bowling Association's jurisdiction may enter by paying \$25.00 for an associate membership card or \$15.00 local association fee if you have another association's current card.

2. **ALL ENTRIES CLOSE ON JUNE 16, 2017.** Entry forms must be filled out in detail; **full name, USBC ID#, Date of Birth and Gender are required. If gate pass is needed, fill out bottom portion of entry form to include Last 4 SSN and DOB. Please print neatly.**

3. **FULL ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM.** All entries will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis. **No telephone reservations. If full payment is received, OBA Office will date-stamp and assign entry number. Partial entry fee will delay assignment of entry numbers.**

Cash, checks or money orders are accepted forms of payment. Any checks returned or not honored by the bank will be assessed a \$30.00 fee and full payment including assessed fee must be made (cash or money order) within 10 days of notification and/or prior to tournament date.

NO REFUNDS OF ENTRY FEES WILL BE AVAILABLE AFTER THE SCHEDULE IS FINALIZED.

4. **TOURNAMENT HANDICAP is 100% of 205.**

5. **AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS: 2015-16 Highest USBC (Bowl.com) STANDARD Average (21+ games)
2015-16 Highest USBC (Bowl.com) COMPOSITE Average (21+ games)
2015-16 Highest USBC (Bowl.com) SPORT/CHALLENGE Average (21+ games) ***
2016-17 Highest Current Average (21+ games) League Standing Sheet must be provided with entry**

6. **AVERAGE ADJUSTMENTS: *** SPORT/CHALLENGE AVERAGES – USBC SCALE WILL BE USED**
a. If you have only a Sport/Challenge Average
b. If you have both Standard and Sport/Challenge Ave your highest standard average shall be used
c. the adjustment scale is not considered a "re-rate". Its purpose is to allow for a fair adjustment to what would be expected of the bowler on a standard condition
d. the adjustment scale does not supersede the ability of a tournament director to further adjust upward any bowler's entering average in a tournament per rule 319c

7. **Tournament check-in is 1 hour prior to squad time.** Tardy bowlers will begin play with the score to count from the frame being bowled but will not be credited with the pins for the missed frames.

8. **Scoring.** Tournament officials will decide if a game or frame(s) within a game will be re-bowled in the event of an irretrievably lost score. **Each bowler must check, verify and sign the score sheet before turning it in.**

9. **Dress Requirements: NO tank tops, sleeveless shirts, shirts with inappropriate graphics or language and short shorts will be allowed. Headwear (for medical reasons) may be worn if approved by the Tournament Director. NO E-CIGS ALLOWED.**

10. Any bowler who appears to be or becomes intoxicated, "under the influence", uses abusive language, obscene gestures or who delays the normal process of the game shall be **immediately removed** from the tournament and the score will be zero (0) for any remaining frames of the games.

11. Any protest involving eligibility or the playing rules must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director and/or Coordinator, local association official or the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) within 72 hours or before prize payments are made. Upon receipt, the tournament committee shall meet and make a decision about the protest, however, the bowler may appeal the decision to the local association or to USBC.

12. Final results will be posted on OBA's home page, www.oahuusbca.org. Prize fund checks will be mailed to each winner as soon as possible, pending a thorough check of all scores, averages and the outcome of any protests or appeals.

13. **PRIZE FUND CHECKS MUST BE CASHED WITHIN 90 DAYS OF ISSUE DATE. NO CHECKS WILL BE RE-ISSUED AFTER THE 90 DAY DEADLINE.**
